Dear Senate President Shaw,

Impact Party was founded in the Fall of 2015 on the basis of being dedicated to students and above party politics and gridlock. Inspire Party was founded in the Fall of 2017 on the premise of making a positive difference for all University of Florida students. I believe both parties in Student Senate have lost sight of their ultimate goal, serving our student body. Student Senate should not be objecting to student organization line-item requests or allocations funding for political purposes. Additionally, instead of lowering the threshold to approve executive appointments, the branches should communicate, collaborate, and compromise with one another. What I mean by communicate, collaborate, and compromise is not sending well over 100 public record requests over the last five weeks, but rather means actually talking to one another and working for the betterment of the student body. For these reasons, I veto Student Senate Law 2019-100 (Student Senate Bill 2019-1046) so the Student Senate can take another look at these revisions and rethink the implication of diminishing how many votes are needed for some of the highest SG positions on campus. It is my hope that with this veto, the Student Senate can re-evaluate the last few weeks and ensure that they are serving our student body.
