## Amendment 1

Every 10 years, the Constitution Revision Commission is established to review the Constitution and propose potential changes. Included on the ballot is the proposed summary of the recommendations of the Constitutional Revision Commission. For the full text of the revision and the original text, please see the poll worker at your polling location.

## Should the Student Body Constitution be amended to:

- remove any reference to the student honor code;
- amend the anti-discrimination section of Article I to adhere to the University of Florida Non-Discrimination Policy;
- add language defining a student's status;
- amend executive position titles to reflect current practices;
- add language clarifying that off-campus areas fall under the Fall Class of senators under Article III;
- change the time for appointment of Summer Replacement Senators from May 1 to the end of the spring academic term;
- require the Student Senate to approve or reject appointments made by the Student Body President within three school weeks;
- remove verbiage that purports to allow the Student Senate to contract on behalf of the student body;
- remove any reference to the "Student Honor Court";
- reaffirm the Student Body Treasurer's veto power on budgetary bills;
- clarify the requirement that the Student Body President has to give a State of the Campus message;
- ensure that terms of executive agency heads are concurrent with the terms of the elected executive officials whom appoint them;
- define Executive Cabinet;
- reaffirm that there are seven justices on the Supreme Court;
- remove completion of Evidence as a requirement to serve on the Supreme Court;
- modify language regarding election dates for clarity;
- define the beginning of student body officer terms as 8:00 AM local time on the last regularly scheduled class day of the spring semester;
- remove the President's cabinet and Vice President's cabinet from Section 1 of Article VII and replace with "Executive Agency Heads" and "Executive Cabinet Directors";
- amend the proposal initiative process to provide that a petition carrying the signatures of 5% of the student body shall be placed on the ballot;
- replace "Director of Student Activities and Involvement" with "primary Student Government advisor" in Section 3 of Article VIII;
- amend the approval vote for ratification to provide that a simple majority of those voting in the spring election is necessary to ratify all constitutional amendments;
- change the effective time of ratified amendments to 8:00 AM local time on the last day of regularly scheduled classes of the spring academic term;
- add definitions of school week, university committee, and academic term to Section 1 of Article IX;
- and make grammatical and other minor corrections and replacements to ensure accuracy.
