- Go into email from Ticketmaster using your mobile device. In the email you should be able to click “view and use mobile tickets” from your device.

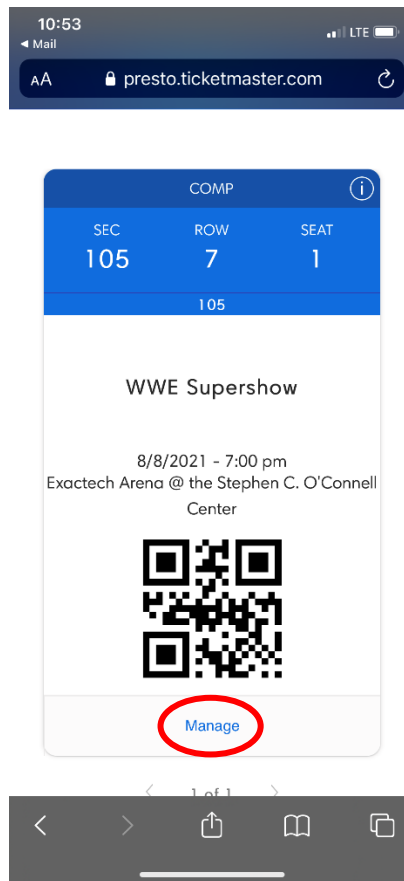

### Step 2:

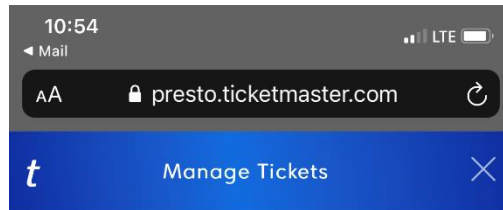
- When the ticket(s) load, you will click “manage” at the bottom. Should look like this:

### Step 3:

- If you are not already logged in on your mobile device you will get the message to “proceed to login”

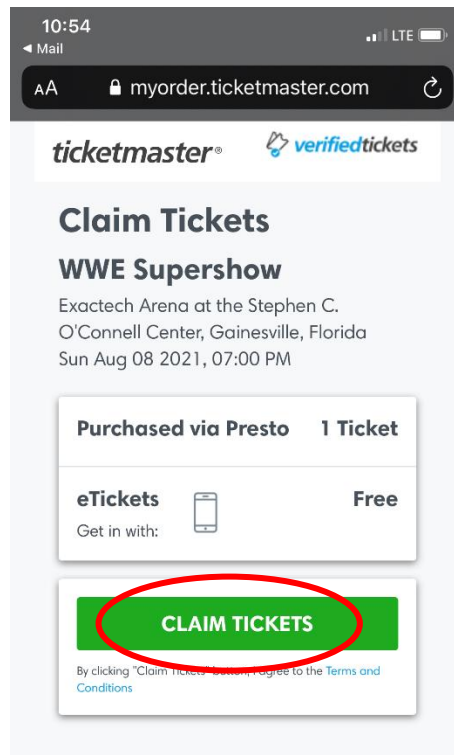


To manage your tickets and get more information about your order, you must use the Ticketmaster app.



### Step 4:

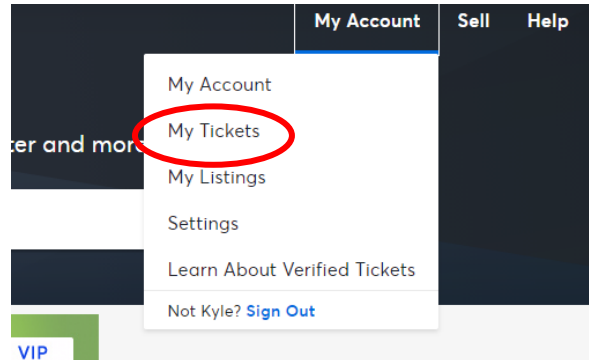
- After logging in, the next screen should prompt you to “claim tickets”. Go ahead and click the green button to do so.


### Step 6:


