TITLE: Online Voting Constitutional Amendment

LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA that the following amendment to Article VI of the Student Body Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors for ratification or rejection at the general election occurring in the Spring semester of 2023:

Insert:

“Section 9: The Supervisor of Elections shall guarantee verified and secured real-time online remote voting on election day in Student Government elections to all members of the electorate”

THEREFORE, LET IT FURTHER BE RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:

Should the Student Body Constitution Article VI be amended to allow for online voting to be included within the Constitution and read as follows,

“Section 9: The Supervisor of Elections shall guarantee verified and secured real-time online remote voting on election day in Student Government elections to all members of the electorate?”
