STUDENT SENATE BILL 2023-1236

TITLE: Presentment for Enactments Reviewal Zone (PERZ) Act

CHAPTER 302 LEGISLATION (98-124, 2000-136, 2015-109)

- 302.1 In accordance with the Student Body Constitution Article III, Section 8(a), no Student Body Law shall be passed without being read and passed by majority vote at two meetings of the Student Senate.
- 302.2 No second reading of a bill shall be considered within twenty-four (24) hours of the start of the meeting at which first passage occurred, except for the provisions of Chapter 302.25.
- 302.25 Second readings may be considered with less than a twenty-four (24) hour interim provided that the meeting at which it is to be considered is called by a 4/5 vote of the Student Senators present at the previous meeting. Second readings of any Activity and Service Fee, Organizational, or Special Events budget may not be overridden in this manner in accordance with Chapter 821.41.
- All bills of law that are passed by the Senate shall be presented first to the Senate President. Upon the Senate President's signature or after ten (10) calendar days upon presentment to the Senate President, the bill will be presented to the Student Body President for signature or veto.
- 302.31The Senate Secretaries will notify the Student Body President and the SenatePresident of the date and time of presentment to the Student Body President
- <u>302.32</u> The Senate Secretaries will notify the Student Body Treasurer and the Senate

President of the date and time of presentment to the Student Body Treasurer for all bills that require their signature.

- 302.4The Activity and Service Fee Budget will be presented to the Senate
President first. Upon the Senate President's signature or after ten (10)
calendar days after presentment, the bill will be presented to the Student
Body Treasurer for signature or veto, and afterward to the Student Body
President for signature or veto.
- <u>302.41</u> Organizational or Special Event Budgets will be presented to the Budget Chairperson for signature first. Upon the Budget Chairperson's signature or after ten (10) calendar days, the budget will be presented to the Student Body Treasurer for signature or veto.
- 302.5 All aforementioned bills upon ten (10) calendar days after presentment or signature by the Student Body President and/or Student Body Treasurer, or following a veto override in the Senate, will be presented to the Vice President of Student Life or the University President's designee for signature or veto.
- <u>302.51</u> Upon signature or after ten (10) calendar days of presentment, the bill will become law.
- <u>302.6</u> <u>A veto is finalized upon the receipt of the veto message by the Senate</u> <u>President from the executive who vetoed the legislation.</u>
- <u>302.7</u> <u>All resolutions, authorizations and changes to the Rules and Procedures will</u> only be presented to the Senate President.
- <u>302.71</u> The Senate President will have ten (10) calendar days to sign resolutions and

authorizations upon presentment.

302.72 The Senate President will have ten (10) school days to sign Rules and Procedures changes. After that period, the change will automatically take effect.
