Meeting of the Student Government Elections Commission March 3, 2023

Elections Commission Chair John Clementi called the meeting to order at 12:14 pm. Commissioners Present: John Clementi, Janelle Rolle, Gabriella Cerasoli, Julia Robinson Move to consolidate complaints: SP23 012-014, SP23 021, SP23 022, and SP23 30-32.

The Commission first considered Complaints SP23 012-014, SP23 021, SP23 022, and SP23 30-32. The Commission heard an opening statement from the Plaintiff and Defendant, a presentation of the complaint by the Plaintiff, a rebuttal by the Defendant, and a closing statement by both the Plaintiff and Defendant. The Commission then voted unanimously in favor of finding a violation for 12-14, 21, 22 during public consideration. The Commission then voted unanimously against finding a violation for 30-32 during public consideration. After public consideration, the Commission found a \$5 penalty for each violation as an appropriate penalty.

Next, the Commission considered SP23 027. The Commission heard an opening statement from the Plaintiff and Defendant, a presentation of the complaint by the Plaintiff, a rebuttal by the Defendant, and a closing statement by both the Plaintiff and Defendant. The Commission then voted unanimously against finding a penalty.

Next, the Commission considered SP23 033. The Commission heard an opening statement from the Plaintiff and Defendant, a presentation of the complaint by the Plaintiff, a rebuttal by the Defendant, and a closing statement by both the Plaintiff and Defendant. The Commission then voted unanimously against finding a penalty.

Next, the Commission considered Complaint SP23 009. The Commission heard an opening statement from the Plaintiff and Defendant, a presentation of the complaint by the Plaintiff, a rebuttal by the Defendant, and a closing statement by both the Plaintiff and Defendant. The Commission then voted unanimously against finding a penalty.

The Commission voted unanimously to recommend the validation of the election results. The meeting was adjourned at 1:15 pm.

Election Commission Hearing (10/5) Minutes

Commissioners Present at the Meeting: Jesse Dieterle Kourtney Booster Pelumi Okeowo Adreanne Martinez Gabriella Cerasoli

Jesse Dieterle called the meeting to order at 4:15 PM on Thursday, October 6th.

The Elections Commission reviewed sixty-five complaints.

- The sixty-five complaints were filed by the Vision Party. No counsel was present for Vision at the hearing.
- Steven Tang and Senate President Oscar Santiago Perez represented the Change Party.
- Senator Raj Mia was present and Senate President Pro Temp, Nathan McGuiness.
- Commissioner Cerasoli motioned to consolidate the complaints under Section 725.8. The motion was seconded by Chairman Dieterle.
- Senate President Santiago Perez offered the opening statement for the Change Party. He
 argued that many of the complaints were filed against individuals who were not
 candidates in the election or affiliates of the Change Party.
- Evidence was presented by Senate President Santiago Perez along with a discussion that all complaints except for Complaint #1 contained a Reg. Pol. Ad. in the Instagram repost.
- Mr. Tang provided the closing statement for the Change Party.
- The Elections Commission moved into deliberation.
- Commission Cerasoli moved to dismiss all sixty-five complaints under Section 725.4. The motion was seconded by Commission Okeowo.
- Commissioners Cerasoli, Okeowo, Martinez, and Booster all voted in agreement to dismiss the complaints filed against the Change Party.
- Commission Okeowo moved to adjourn the meeting, which Chairman Dieterle seconded.

Election Commission Minutes

Commissioners Present at the Meeting: Jesse Dieterle Kourtney Booster Pelumi Okeowo Jewelia Bradley Gabriella Cerasoli

Jesse Dieterle called the meeting to order at 3:00 PM on Monday, September 18.

The Elections Commission reviewed the Polling Sites under Section 723.2.

- Jesse Dieterle read a written, public comment from Mia Raj. The comment advocated for adding Marston Library as a polling location.
- Senate President Oscar Santiago Perez provided a public comment at the meeting in favor of Marston Library as a polling location.
- The Commission moved to vote on the polling sites provided by the Supervisor of Elections.
- **Commissioners** ("Kourtney Booster, Pelumi Okeowo, Jewelia Bradley, Gabriella Cerasoli") voted in favor of the following polling sites:
 - Broward Recreation Room Health Science Center Library Heavener Hall Levin School of Law Norman Hall Educational Library Reitz Union Computer Printing Lab Southwest Recreation Center Springs Library and Recreation Room
- Jesse Dieterle moved to adjourn the meeting.

The Elections Commission reviewed six complaints.

- Nathaniel Pelton represented Change Party. Evan Rafanan represented Vision Party. Before the meeting, Gator Party waived attending the meeting as respondent in Complaint #7.
- Jesse Dieterle called the meeting to order at 3:10 PM on Monday, September 18.
- Pelumi Okeowo moved to consolidate Complaints #1, 3, 4, 5, & 7. The Commissioners decided on this issue unanimously.
- Mr. Pelton and Mr. Rafanan provided opening statements, offered evidence and rebuttal evidence, and final statements.
- The Commission deliberated and decided there was no violation of Section 762.0 for Complaints #4, 5, and 7. The Commissioners decided on this issue unanimously.
- Mr. Rafanan conceded violations of Section 762.0 for Complaints #1 and 3.
- The Commission decided to issue warnings against Vision Party for Complaints #1 and 3. The Commissioners decided on this issue unanimously.
- Jesse Dieterle moved to review Complaint #2.

- Mr. Pelton and Mr. Rafanan provided opening statements on Complaint #2. Both Mr. Pelton and Mr. Rafanan waived offering evidence and rebuttal evidence to the Commission. Mr. Pelton and Mr. Rafanan provided final statements.
- There were two claims under Complaint #2 under Sections 761.1 and 762.0.
- Mr. Pelton sought a \$25 fine under Section 761.1 and a \$5 under Section 762.0.
- The Commissioners decided that there was a violation under Section 762.0
- The Commissioners voted unanimously that there was no violation under Section 761.1, which was dismissed.
- Under the Section 762.0 violation, the Commissioners decided to issue a warning to Vision party for Complaint #2.
- Jesse Dieterle moved to adjourn the meeting.

Election Commissions Hearing (10/12): Minutes Commissioners Present at the Meeting: Jesse Dieterle Pelumi Okeowo Adreanne Martinez Gabriella Cerasoli Jewelia Robinson

Jesse Dieterle called the meeting to order at 12:00 PM on Thursday, October 12th.

Chairman Dieterle moved to consolidate Complaints #1-9 under Section 725.8. Nathaniel Pelton and Oscar Perez Santiago represented Change Party as the Petitioner. While Evan Rafanan represented Vision Party as the Respondent.

Nathanial Pelton provided an opening statement. He argued that the Department of Housing did not provide permission for the fliers and banners which were in violation of the SAI policies. Furthermore, Vision Party needed to prove that they reached out for permission to post the fliers in Complaints #4-9. Vision party needs to be held liable for individual violations and there were clear violations of Section 746.0 and the SAI policies.

Evan Rafanan responded that the banners in Complaints #1-3 were taken down quickly after noticing the violation, and Vision Party would accept a \$5 fine. Rafanan conceded to the allegations in all nine complaints.

Nathaniel Pelton and Oscar Perez Santiago provided evidence of the allegations and a closing statement. Pelton specifically advocated for a fine great than \$5.

Commissioner Okeowo moved for deliberations, which was seconded by Commissioner Robinson. Commissioner Okeowo moved to vote on whether there were violations under Section 746.0 as alleged in the nine Complaints. Commissioners Cerasoli, Okeowo, Martinez, and Robinson all voted in agreement that Vision Party violated Section 746.0 in the nine consolidated complaints.

Chairman Dieterle moved to discuss the penalties incurred by the Section 746.0. Oscar Santiago Perez argued for a \$5 nominal fine for the six fliers and either a \$25 fine or public reprimand for the three banners. Nathanial Pelton concurred and argued that a public reprimand is necessary as a point to future parties and to protect against abnormal environmental harm.

Evan Rafanan for Vision Party responded that he yelled at members in his party to take down the banners and that he left it up to the Elections Commission to take levy an appropriate fine.

Commissioner Robinson argued that removing the banners and conceding was very helpful. Vision Party apparently would not want to repeat this harm and the future.

Commissioner Robinson moved to vote on a \$5 nominal fine for the six fliers in Complaints #4-9, which was seconded by Commissioner Cerasoli. Commissioners Cerasoli, Okeowo, Martinez, and Robinson all voted in agreement that Vision Party pay a \$5 nominal fine in total for Complaints #4-9.

Chairman Dieterle moved to vote on a \$25 nominal fine for the three banners in Complaints #1-3, which was seconded by Commissioner Martinez. Commissioners Cerasoli, Okeowo, Martinez, and Robinson all voted in agreement that Vision Party pay a \$25 nominal fine in total for Complaints #1-3.
