CHAPTER 313 – SENATORIAL MEMBER ORGANIZATIONS ACT (2023-141)

- Officials of the Student Senate are permitted to form <u>and chair Senatorial Member</u>
 Organizations (SMOs) consisting of <u>fellow</u> members <u>of the student senate</u>
 representing a specific identity group or sharing a common legislative agenda.
- Members of a Senatorial Member Organization may determine the structure, leadership, and function of their Senatorial Member Organization so long as such structure does not interfere with the Student Body Constitution, Senate Rules and Procedures, or other bylaws herein,
- 313.003 Student Government Advising and Operations shall maintain and update the

 Student Government Website to include the Chairs and members of Senatorial

 Member Organization.
- 313.010 Upon the agreement of the structure, leadership, and function of an SMO, the leader, or their designee, shall contact Student Government Advising and Operations to inform them of the SMOs membership and leadership makeup. The name, purpose, constitution, membership, and leadership of a Senatorial Member Organization shall be communicated by the Senatorial Member Organization to Student Government Advising and Operations upon the Senatorial Member Organization's inception or change of any of these data.
- Senatorial Member Organizations do not share the same privileges as Political Parties as outlined in Rule XVII of the Senate Rules and Procedures, as such, they shall not receive representation on the Replacement and Agenda Standing Committee of the Senate, nor enjoy any other right guaranteed to Political Parties in the bylaws herein.
- Senatorial Membership Organizations may otherwise be known informally as Caucuses of the Student Senate.
