STUDENT SENATE BILL 2024-1359

TITLE: Resolution Authorizing the Fall 2024 Election Dates

SPONSOR(S):

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 of the Student Body Constitution states that "If any hour of any day of a general or run-off election conflicts with a religious or school holiday or if any other conflict exists, the Student Senate shall, by resolution, designate different days for the affected election or elections;" and,

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 2 of the Student Body Constitution states that "The fall general election shall occur on the Tuesday and Wednesday of the sixth week of the fall term;" and, WHEREAS, the fall academic school year will begin on August 22nd, and six weeks following that date would be the week of September 29th, making the election dates October 1st and 2nd [1]; and,

WHEREAS, October 2nd marks the beginning of Rosh Hashanah, which celebrates the New Year on the first day of Tishrei. This holiday is a day of remembrance and allows for members for the Jewish faith to participate in a period of self-examination and reflection. This holiday is an integral part of the Jewish faith, thus creating a conflict [2][3]; then,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT the University of Florida Student Senate authorizes the Supervisor of Elections to hold the Fall 2024 general election on October 8th and October 9th.
