RULE VII

VOTING

(AMENDED: 2014-106, 2016-117, 2018-123, 2019-124, 2019-138, 2020-1064, 2021-104, 2023-118, 2023-127, 2023-191, 2024-144, 2024-147, 2024-267)

- 1. Standard Voting Procedure:
 - a. Unless otherwise stated, the standard method for all votes requiring a majority will be by rising vote. (not counted), and the method for all votes requiring two-thirds, two-fifths, or one-fifth of the body will be done by electronic clicker.
 - i. Senators with physical disabilities that prevent them from standing may instead raise their hand to indicate their vote. Senators wishing to use this accommodation must notify the Senate President via email within two weeks of the beginning of their first legislative term.
 - 1. This accommodation also allows for the individual Senator to be recognized by the Chair of the Senate through raising their hand.
