**Topics discussed:**

A. Updates

- a. Main agenda is to work with Nightlife Navigators on presentations and implement infrastructure on campus
- b. Dorm presentations to freshman
  - i. would include overall safety message explaining Blue Light systems, driving on campus, alcohol amnesty, driving under the influence, and medical amnesty
  - ii. Implement sign giving credit where credit is due to SG (sign stating "Funded by UF SG")
- c. Nightlife Navigators (SG) and IRHA combination in order to host and fund educational and fun events
  - i. IRHA might not want to collaborate with SG in order to separate them from SG
  - ii. Recommend changing language on presentation to Nightlife Navigators in order to be more enticing to students to use medical amnesty
  - iii. Present at Greek Chapter Houses targeting younger students
    1. present at both Greek Chapter Houses and dormitories
    2. Similar format to "Flipping the System" presentation
    3. Have a vice chair and an ambassador be the primary presenters and look into the possibility of an officer helping aid the presentation
      - a. UFPD seems enthusiastic in helping

- b. Target fraternities mainly because they have not received presentations or any pertinent information about campus safety
  - 4. Possibly give merch
  - 5. Residence Hall presentations could also be done by individual RAs
  - 6. HONE IN ON MEDICAL AMNESTY IMPORTANCE DRINK WATER AND EAT BREAD AND SLOW DOWN  
UBER/LYFT/SNAP AND USE YOUR RESOURCES
  - 7. Be personable throughout presentations and emphasize that it is not shameful
- iv. Infrastructure on Hull road is needed
  - 1. few crosswalks, no lights or signs on the road
  - 2. resolutions have been passed promoting the need for infrastructure in the form of a speed bump or speed table
  - 3. have discussed with UFPD
  - 4. need to draw funds
  - 5. a normal speed bump would hurt buses and require raised crosswalks
  - 6. Potential budgeting for raised crosswalk overtime?
  - 7. Thermoplastic markings on roads could be beneficial
    - a. roughly \$700 - \$800 for each thermoplastic signage
    - b. Some are designed to glow in the dark
  - 8. Lighting is also a major concern for the committee
- d. When to meet again?!
